Program

Indian institutes of Technologies (IITs) are the premier institutes of education and training in the country. The students graduating from these institutions are taken to possess all the qualities and talents necessary for a successful career. The IIT brand sells all over the world and IIT graduates have made mark in all field of the society and world workforce scene. There are 15 IITs located in different parts of the country. Getting admission in an IIT is a dream of many hundred thousands of students in the country. In the case of the state of Punjab, though an IIT has been opened in Roop Nagar, however, this has not in any way improved the number of students from the state getting admission in any IIT. The situation is more grim for rural students of Punjab, because of collapse of rural education, particularly, science education.

Keeping in view the poor condition of rural science education in Punjab and initiative taken by Prof. A.S .Brar, Vice Chancellor, Guru Nanak Dev University, and keen interest shown by Chief Minister S. Parkash Singh Badal , it was decided to select fifty students from rural Punjab after matriculation through an entrance test. The selected students are provided free specialized education for 10+1 and 10+2 classes (total 2 years). They are also provided free lodging, boarding, books, study material, stationary and all other requisite facilities. Punjab Govt. has sanctioned the grant and constituted a committee under the chairmanship of Prof. A.S Brar, Vice Chancellor, Guru Nanak Dev University for implementation of the program. The First batch was admitted in 2010 and has already completed one year (10+1); the students of first batch have now joined 10+2 class.

The process for selection of second batch has been initiated. After selection the students for the second batch will be formally admitted to Khalsa College Public School, Amritsar. They will be provided lodging and boarding by Khalsa College Management Trust. The students will be taught by selected professionals as per the syllabus of CBSE. Highly qualified teachers will be employed so that students are taught at higher level making all the concepts clear to them. They will be provided daily special training by experts in the evening, preparing them simultaneously for IIT entrance Test .

ADMISSION GUIDELINES

A. General

The candidates should submit their application forms and Entrance Test fee to the office of Dean Students' Welfare Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar.

B. Eligibility

- i) Having passed Matriculation examination in 2011 with at least 60% marks or CGPA of 6.32 out of 10 (in case of CBSE) from a school in Punjab or Chandigarh.
- ii) Residing in a rural area as evidenced by name of parents in the voter list/
Photocopy of voter ID Card.
- iii) Annual income of parents less than Rs. 4.0 lac. from all sources
- iv) Must be a domicile of Punjab.

C. How to apply

Candidate can download the application form from GNDU website www.gndu.ac.in or collect the same from Prof. M.P.S.Ishar, Dean Students' Welfare, Guru Nanak Dev University or Enquiry counter Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar. The duly completed form along with a entrance test fee should be submitted in the office of Dean Students' Welfare, Guru Nanak Dev University, Amritsar on or before 30-4-2011.

Rural Area Certificate, Punjab Domicile Certificate and Income Certificate will have to be produced at the time of counselling by the candidates who qualify in the entrance test.

D. Entrance Test Fee

Entrance Test Fee of Rs.500/- in the form of demand draft drawn in favor of **PROGRESSIVE EDUCATIONAL SOCIETY, Amritsar, payable at Amritsar**, should be deposited along with application form.
